The Budget Hearing was advertised as a legal notice for the Claridon Township Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year ending December 31, 2023.

The Fiscal Officer gave an overview of the budget for 2023, including information for the General Fund, Fire and EMS Funds, Gasoline Tax Fund, Road and Bridge Levy Fund, Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, Cemetery Fund, Zoning Fund, and Permissive Motor Vehicle Tax Fund.

The Board of Trustees were presented with a packet of documents which provided a 5-year overview of all funds and the current proposed Budget for 2023.

Mr. Tom Niewulis, Claridon Resident, asked questions pertaining to the upcoming Taylor Wells North Road project and the potential Road And Bridge Levy for 2023. There were no other comments or questions.


MOTION TO ADJOURN- 22-82
