

**RECORDS OF PROCEEDINGS
CLARIDON TOWNSHIP
BUDGET HEARING**

June 26, 2023

The Budget Hearing was called to order at 6:00pm with the following members present: Trustees-Cooper Sherman, Roger Miller, Jonathan Tiber and Fiscal Officer- Paula Hietanen.

Ms. Hietanen took roll call for attendance. Mr. Sherman, Mr. Miller and Mr. Tiber responded here.

The Budget Hearing was advertised as a legal notice for the Claridon Township Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year ending December 31, 2024.

The Fiscal Officer gave an overview of the budget for 2024, including information for the General Fund, Fire and EMS Funds, Gasoline Tax Fund, Road and Bridge Levy Fund, Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, Cemetery Fund, Zoning Fund, Permissive Motor Vehicle Tax Fund, and ARPA funds.

The Board of Trustees were presented with a packet of documents which provided a 5-year overview of all funds and the current proposed Budget for 2024.

Mr. Tom Niewulis, Claridon Resident, asked questions pertaining to the changes in revenue for property taxes. Ms. Hietanen explained that the changes are due to Aquilla Village separating from Claridon Township. He also asked about a potential Road and Bridge Levy for 2024. The BOT noted that the levy will be discussed in future meetings. There were no other comments or questions.
